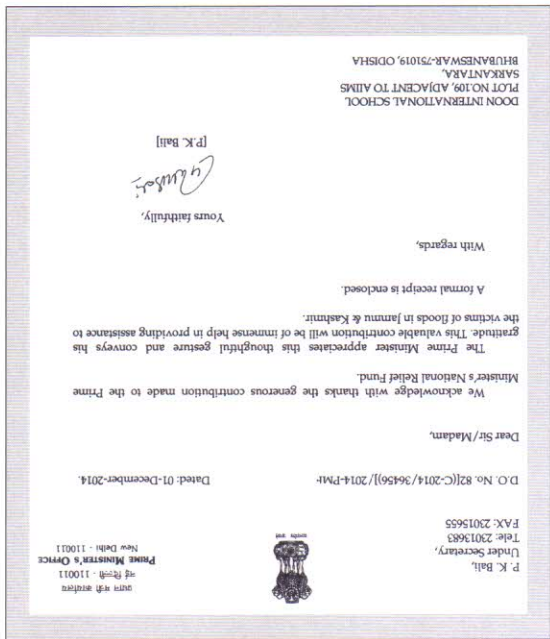

In such an event, the parents will be liable to pay for the entire next school term even if the child does not attend the school. Applications for refund of Caution Money must reach the school office not later than 31st December of the year in which the child last attended the school. The same shall be processed and cheque for refunds will reach the parents within 3 months.

## Withdrawals :

Permissions to attend special functions at home shall not be usually granted, as a safeguard both for health and study. Parents may visit or take their children out, for a maximum of two outings a month on Sundays and Holidays only. Children must return to school latest by 6:00pm. Besides parents, no other relatives will be permitted to take the child out for the night. Parents are requested to discourage frequent visits and outings, as the child will then take very long time to settle down and concentrate on his/her studies. When permitted to go out, children must be accompanied by their parents or by some duly authorized person. On their return they must report to the Matron/House Master. No student will be allowed out with friends or relatives unless a written permission from the parents is available.  
Letters of authorization should be written on official letter head paper with complete details. No child will be allowed to go out with a brother or sister studying in other schools.

## General Regulations :

No withdrawals are ordinarily permitted during mid-session, except in special circumstances and are convincing to the management of the school. No refunds will be allowed, nor deductions made in fees and dues payable as per fee regulations. Three months advance notice in writing shall be required if a parent wishes not to send the child for the following session. Ordinarily, such notices should reach the school not later than 31st December of the year preceding that in which the child is sought to be withdrawn. It will be assumed that the parent has given consent for the enrolment of the child for the next year and accommodation will be reserved for
